As outlined in the email message dated July 7, 2009, funding for NCVIP services will transition to the LEA beginning July 1, 2010. The Video Team at ITS has worked diligently to make this transition as smooth as possible. ITS is continuing to look into lowering rates and will give sites 2 months worth of credit for recurring services in June of 2011 so that your site will not have to pay for 2 months of summer downtime. ITS provides the following rate plans and features for their Video Conferencing service:

- **NCVIP Monthly subscription service (\$580.20)** - Based on a monthly flat rate for unlimited usage and the 1st video endpoint certified on your network/LEA. ITS provides customers with technical support and consultation, endpoint configuration, training in the use of network resources, and certification to the ITS network. The NCVIP service features access to a web-based scheduling interface. This interface is used to schedule all video conferences and provides access to a Multipoint Control Unit (MCU). ITS supports only sessions built on its own Multipoint Control Unit (MCU) and does not support sessions built on endpoint internal MCUs.
- **NCVIP2 Monthly subscription rate (\$318.50)** - The NCVIP2 monthly subscription service provides all of the same features of the NCVIP service but is billed at a reduced rate for additional video endpoints added to the same network/LEA.
- **Ad hoc service (\$29/hour)** - The ad hoc service provides all of the same features of the NCVIP service but is billed on a prorated hourly rate. Your site will only be charged for usage incurred. There is currently no recurring fee for this service. As with all of the video conferencing services your site(s) will be listed in the web-based scheduler.
