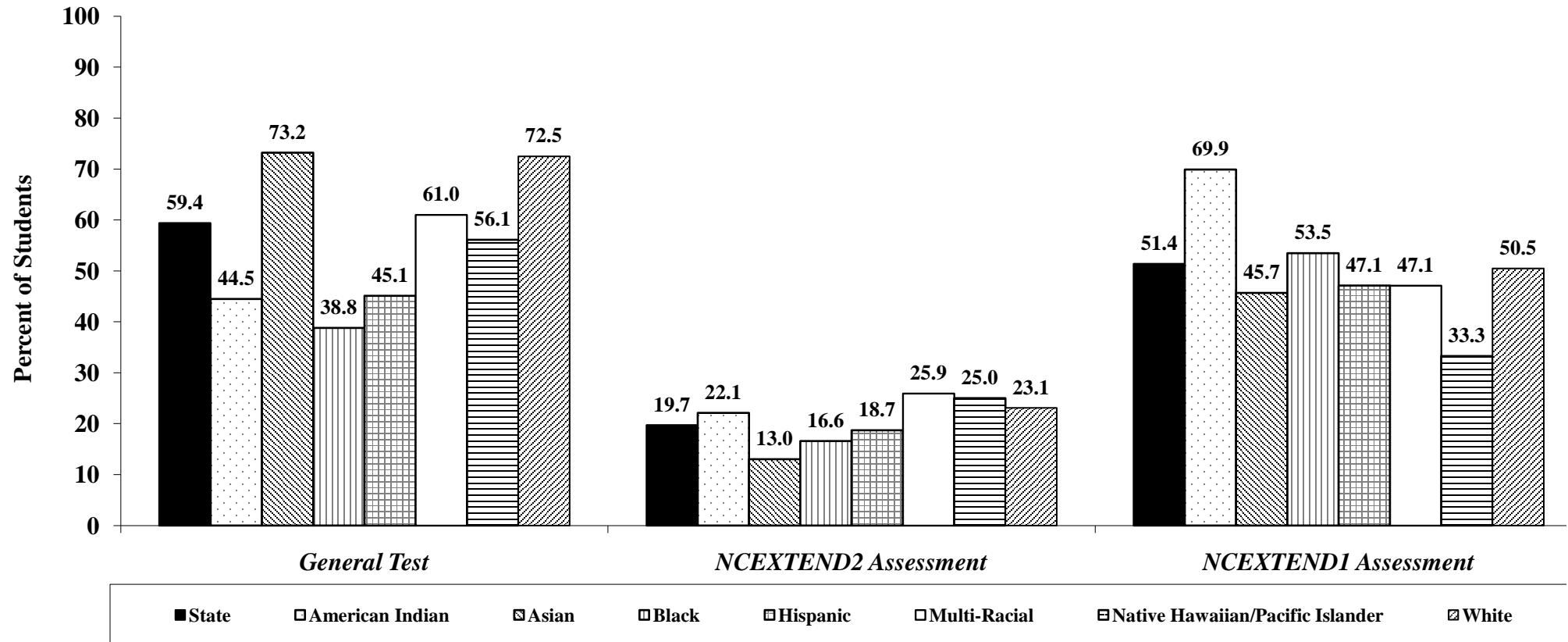


**Figure 1. 2010-11 End-of-Grade General Test and Alternate Assessments Results

Grades 3-8, by Test Type and Ethnicity**



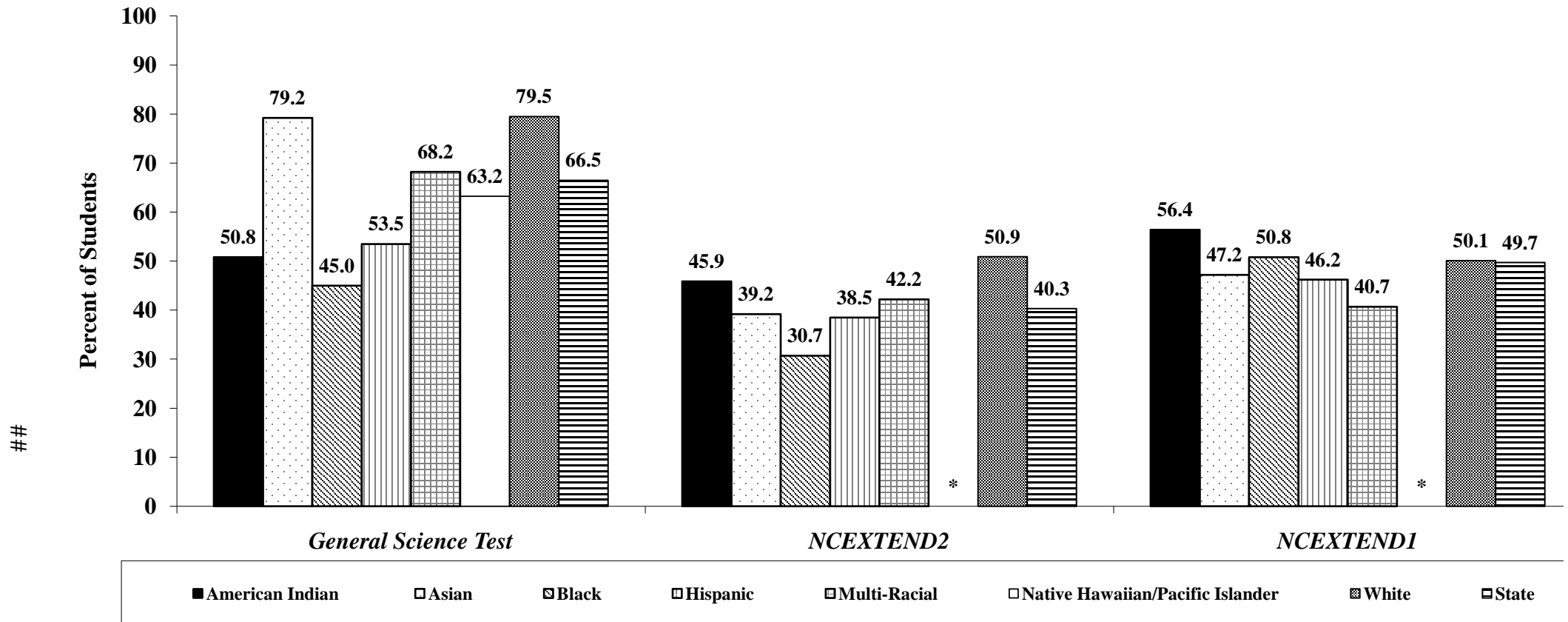
