³Reminder: Students who began eighth grade prior to the 2000-2001 school year and have not fulfilled the mathematics part of the proficiency requirement must be administered competency forms that measure the 1989 curriculum. For students who began eighth grade during or after the 2000-2001 school year, the competency mathematics forms must measure the 1998 curriculum.

⁴NCAAAI (North Carolina Alternate Assessment Academic Inventory) is conducted three times annually: Once during the first month of student participation, once during the first month of the second semester, and once during the final month of school.
