

Grade 13

In order to prepare for the 2009-2010 school year, Grade 13 was recently added to NC WISE. Doing so at this time of year allows LEAs and schools to transition appropriate students to 13th grade for next year.

Starting in the 2009-2010 school year, UERS reports will be modified to pick up Grade 13 students. However, the reports are not ready yet and will not reflect Grade 13 until next school year. Schools should add Grade 13 to their list of Grades Taught on the Grades and Catchments screen (School > School Information > School Details > More Info > Grades and Catchments). However, students should only be assigned to Grade 13 on the Pre-Transition List. Please do not change the grade level for students in the current school year. If schools have already moved students to Grade 13 in the current year, please move these students back to 12th grade. Homeroom History records will have to be corrected as well.

Information regarding how and why to assign students to Grade 13 will be coming soon in the updated YET documentation and the YET Refreshers in April.
