

BUD RELEASE 8.3.0

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

INTRODUCTION

Below are complete instructions that explain how to install BUD Release 8.3.0 from the file sent to you via FTP. The BUD Release Administrator and/or your i5 or iSeries System Administrator should perform the following procedures. Excluding the back up steps, these procedures will take approximately 5 minutes to complete. An on-line backup can be used to supplement your daily backups.

BEFORE BEGINNING

You **MUST** perform the following procedures before you proceed with the remaining installation instructions:

1. **IMPORTANT: Verify that you have received all the files sent from DPI. To do this you will need to sign on to the BUD system as BUDPUSER and run SURF.**

Verify that you have sent all files to DPI. To do this you will need to sign on to the BUD system as BUDPUSER and run SEND.

Sign off the system as BUDPUSER.

2. Sign on to the system as **QSECOFR**.

3. Verify that the save files exist on your system by doing the following:

- Type **WRKOBJ QGPL/BUD830OB** on the command line and press ENTER.

On the "Work with Objects" screen, you should see the following:

BUD830OB *FILE QGPL SAVF

- * After verifying that the save file exists, press F12 to return to the command line.

NOTE: If you do not see the save file call the DPI help desk for assistance at (919) 807- 4357. Please reference BUD release 8.3.0 installation in your call.

4. Ensure all BUD users are signed off while you are install the new release.
5. Please back up the BUD program and data libraries using the SYSTEM Save Library (SAVLIB) command. Enter **BUDP** and **BUDPFILE** in the library field.

INSTALLING THE BUD RELEASE

NOTE: The system does not need to be in a "restricted state" for this installation however, the BUD users must be signed off during this process.

The procedures listed below **MUST** be performed in the order specified to load the BUD Release 8.3.0 onto your SYSTEM.

- _____ 1. If you have not already done so, sign on to your SYSTEM by entering **QSECOFR** (in the User ID field) and the password on the SYSTEM Sign On screen.

You should see: ... Main Menu.

- _____ 2. Type **==> RSTOBJ OBJ(BUD830INS) SAVLIB(BUD83SRC) DEV(*SAVF) SAVF(QGPL/BUD830OB) MBROPT(*ALL) ALWOBJDIF(*NONE) RSTLIB(QGPL)** on the command line and press ENTER.

You should see: 1 objects restored from BUD83SRC to QGPL.

Results: The Release 8.3.0 installation program has been installed to the QGPL library.

- _____ 3. Type **CALL PGM(QGPL/BUD830INS)** and press ENTER.

You should see: Message "Did you back up BUDP and BUDPFIL before beginning this install? Y/N." **If this message does not appear on screen, type DSPMSG on the command line to key in your response.**

User input: If you have already backed up the BUDP and BUDPFIL libraries, key in Y and press Enter. If you have not backed up BUDP and BUDPFIL libraries, key in N and press Enter.

Effect: If Y is entered, the installation program will run to completion.

If N is entered, the installation program will terminate to allow you to backup the BUDP and BUDPFIL libraries before continuing. After you have backed up the BUDP and BUDPFIL libraries, restart this procedure at Step 3.

NOTE: Depending on several factors, including system activity and configuration, either one of the following two messages may appear first, followed by the other. This is not an error and is no cause for concern. **If this message does not appear on screen, type DSPMSG on the command line to display the messages.**

You should see: Message "DPI has been notified of the successful implementation of BUD 8.3.0 for your LEA. Press Enter to continue."

User input: Press Enter.

You should see: Message "BUD 8.3.0 Installation completed successfully! Press Enter to continue."

User input: Press Enter.

Effect: Release 8.3.0 installation is complete.

- _____ 4. When the installation program has completed, sign off and then sign back onto the SYSTEM as **BUDPUSER**. Type **BUDP/BUDS** and press Enter on the command line to enter the BUD system.

You should see: Budget Development Utilization System Menu appears with **Version 8.3.0** in the upper right-hand corner.

Note: If you do not see the correct version number on the screen, call the Help Desk (919-807-4357) before signing off of the system. **Do not continue with the installation instructions.**

- _____ 5. Exit from the system by typing **90** on any BUD menu.

- _____ 6. Back up BUD program and data libraries using the SYSTEM Save Library (SAVLIB) command on a new set of media. Enter **BUDP** and **BUDPFILE** in the Library field. You will now have a complete back up of the before release image and the after release installed image.

You have now installed and verified the new release.
