This document meets the requirements outlined by the U. S. Department of Education. Any changes that may be requested by the U.S. Department of Education will be made and the Consolidated Application resubmitted in a timely manner to ensure the flow of funds under No Child Left Behind on or about July 1, 2002.

Once North Carolina's Consolidated application is approved, work will begin on the preparation of the adequate yearly progress requirements. Adequate yearly progress materials will be submitted no later than January 31, 2003.

Once regulations and guidelines are published, refinement of the Consolidated Application will begin. The final Consolidated Application will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Education no later than May 31, 2003.
