



Today's students will face challenges our generation has yet to imagine. This facilitated course will focus on helping teachers ensure that every student is ready to meet those challenges. The 21st Century Skills Framework developed by the Partnership for 21st Century Skills will guide our discussion. You will observe and analyze model lessons to identify 21st century skills and methods of teaching them, design a lesson that incorporates 21st century skills and tools, and collaborate with colleagues to critique lessons developed by other participants.

This course is an instructor taught course by a NCDPI professional. This five-week course will take approximately 10 hours to complete. This course is taught entirely online, allowing participants the flexibility to complete the course on their own schedule though there will be weekly deadlines to meet.

Enrollment is limited to 30 participants.
