Special provisions in Senate Bill 202 and technical corrections House Bill 836 recently passed by the General Assembly state that the State Board of Education “may” proceed as indicated in the bill to redirect or use funds. Some special provisions mandate the State Board of Education proceed with the actions. Included in these provisions is the authorization for the State Board of Education to adopt emergency rules to grant maximum flexibility to LEAs regarding the expenditure of State funds. These special provisions are being presented for the Board’s review and for authorization of the allowed actions.
